We hope you are looking forward to ClubFest 2022. Please take a few moments to read the following, which will help you know what to expect when you arrive at ClubFest 2022. We look forward to welcoming you to ClubFest 2022.

Arriving:

ClubFest gates will open at 08:00 on Wednesday 1 June. The pre-event campsite opens on Friday 27 May at 08:00.

Please follow the yellow ClubFest and local signage as you approach ClubFest. Please do not use your Sat-Nav once you have picked up the route.

Included in this pack is a hanger for your rear view mirror. The colour on the front represents the gate you need to arrive at. Red hanger for Red Gate or blue Hanger for Blue Gate.

The letter represents the block we have allocated for you. You will be directed to your block on arrival and the Campsite Crew will direct you to your pitch. We will not be able to move your pre-allocated block. If you arrive after 22:00 you will be given a temporary pitch, with no EHU, and moved to your permanent pitch in the morning.

Please have your windscreen hanger in place and the document envelope to hand in your vehicle as you arrive at ClubFest 2022.

Arriving with Friends:

If you wish to be pitched near to someone, you will need to have booked the same block and arrive together. Unfortunately, there will be no space at the gates or within the site to wait for friends.

Pitching:

Pitches at ClubFest are all set in parkland, so wedges may be required to level outfits. The grass will have been cut before you arrive. Once electric cables have been laid no further cutting can be carried out

A free-standing or 'pup' tent may be erected in the space on the nearside of the outfit that would otherwise be occupied by an awning. For safety please erect a barrier fence around any tent of less than 1m high and use reflective tape to mark the guy lines.

Blue Badge Area:

If you have booked a Blue Badge pitch, Campsite Crew will be on hand to assist you. We do our best to make the event as accessible as possible, but there may be parts of the site that are not suitable for wheelchair or scooter access. Please be careful when using motorised scooters around the site.

What should I do first:

Once pitched and settled in you should make your way to your Campsite Crew post – they will have your event information and refuse sacks. The central Village area opens at 10:00 on Wednesday 1 June and the Campsite Crew will be able to direct you and offer advice if needed.

What services to expect:

Fresh water is available at the service points; to keep these areas in good condition please don't wash pans, clothing or anything else under these taps.

Motorhomes

Please note that there are no specific service points for motorhomes on-site. If your payload allows you may want to arrive with an initial supply of water on board. You will be directed to temporary water points on arrival before moving to your pitch. Please come prepared to decant grey water and fill up without moving

Waste

Elsan waste should be disposed of into the tanks provided. Please only rinse toilet tanks at the designated taps.

All household waste, except glass, should be put into standard bin bags and placed into the compounds provided. Separate bins will be provided for glass. Hazardous items (medical waste, sharps, batteries, broken glass etc) should be taken home with you for disposal. All ClubFest waste will be taken for sorting, recycling and reuse.

Hook-ups

The vast majority of pitches will be within the range of a 25m hook-up cable, but occasionally you may need a longer cable. Please bring a minimum of 25m hook-up cable. An additional cable is advisable.

All pitches are 6 amp, you will be able to use hair dryers, TV's and kettles, but not all at the same time! For more information please see the EHU information leaflet provided.

Your own sanitation and washing facilities are essential. There will be a number of toilet blocks provided in The Village area for use whilst in that area, but they will be unavailable after 23:00 each day.
