



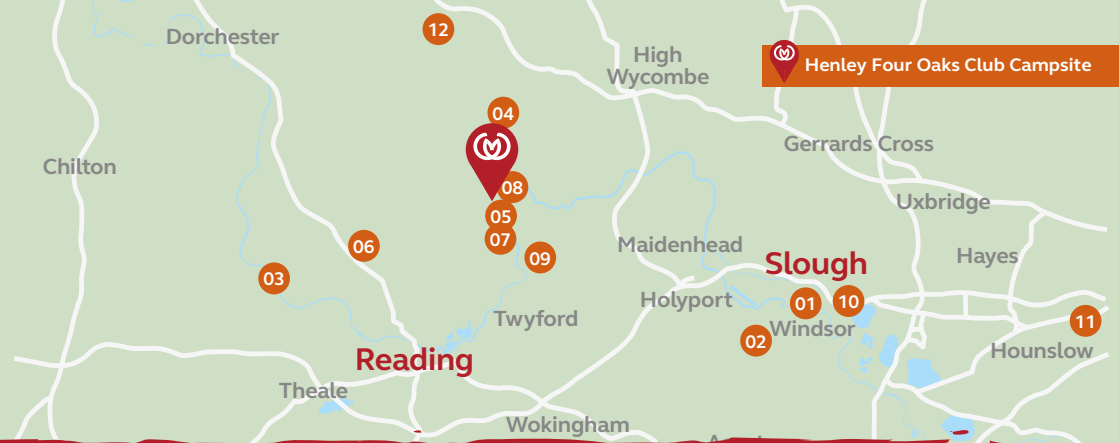

## Visitor's top tips

Once the Regatta has finished in the summer, you can catch a bus into Marlow and hop on the boat back, taking in the 3 locks along the river.

There is a towpath along the Hambledon Lock, perfect for a 'stretch of the legs'.

Take a picnic and spend an afternoon people watching by the river in Henley.

Take a visit to Windsor, the castle is a must.


Try the real ale trail for a good introductory, informative walk around the town.

Nuffield Place (NT), previously the home of William Morris is a really interesting visit.

Driving distance to Legoland, Chessington, Thorpe Park and day trip to London – a great opportunity to use Merlin Passes!

Take a look at the church and house used in Vicar of Dibley and in the same town, the windmill used in Chitty Chitty Bang Bang.

Henley and Marlow shops are a must.

Greys Court is a wonderful day out if you like gardens – especially the walled garden.
